- Comply with professional and general health and safety best practice.
- Cordon off work areas and provide warning where practical,
- Store and use materials, tools and equipment to avoid causing inconvenience or hazard.
- Minimise inconvenience to parishioners.
- Do not work under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- Report any incidents to the Parish Clerk in writing.
- To complete work agreed in a timely manner.
- Do not do any additional work without the approval of the Clerk.
